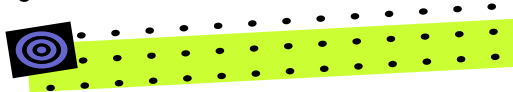

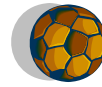

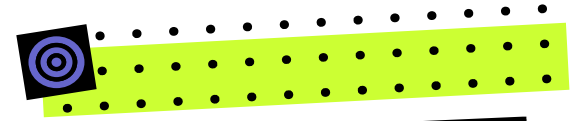
All Deaf/Hard of Hearing children of all races, religions and cultures are welcome.
